
## **International Tiger day**
















The theme for this year was "Mathematics for the better world". Students were given different activities where math was correlated with real life situations.



# CO - CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES





Muskaan bafna grade 9 was placed 3rd in individual Kumite conducted by Thiruvalluvar district karate championship on 26th September 2021.




