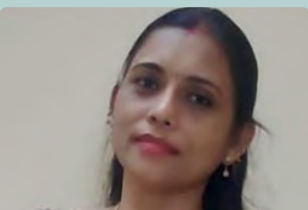
From the editors,

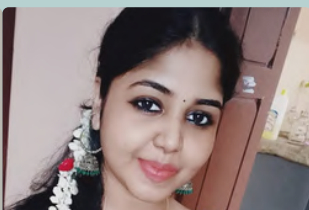

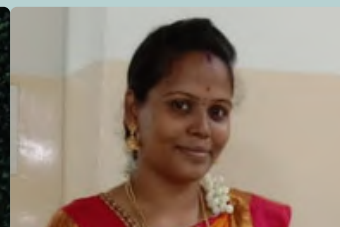

The FOCUS gives a glimpse of the all the activities that were planned meticulously for the holistic development of children taking into account all the changes required.

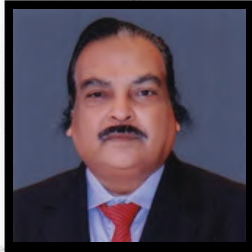

For effective implementation of the teaching learning process, Students were divided into small groups during the online classes.



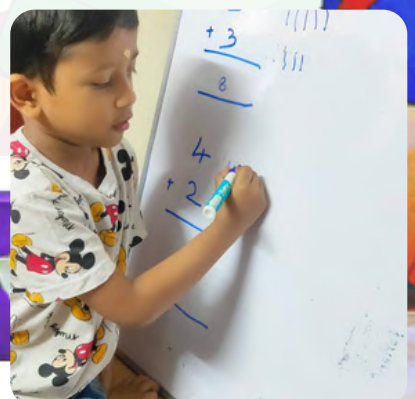
Offline class

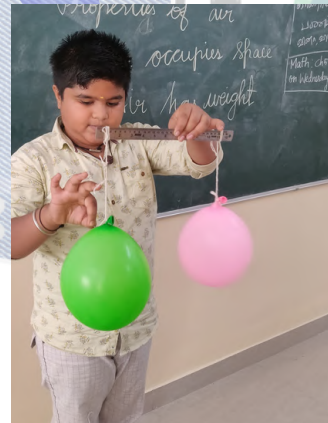
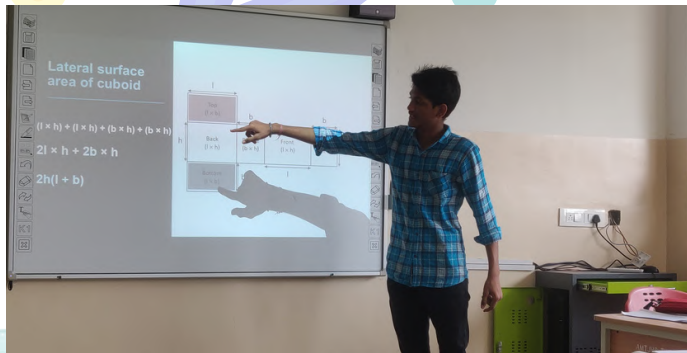
KC class Activities

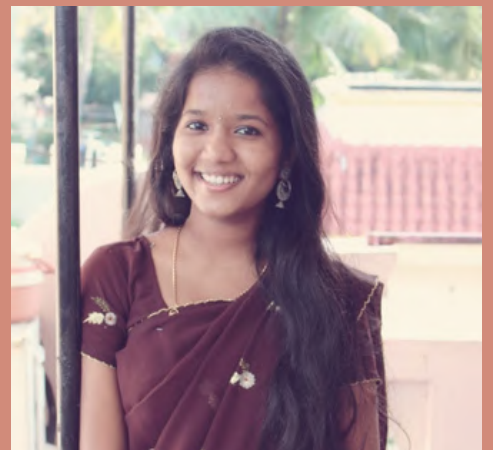
Ayudha pooja

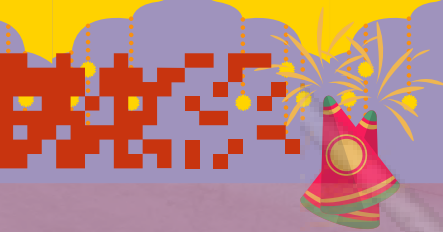

21.06.2021

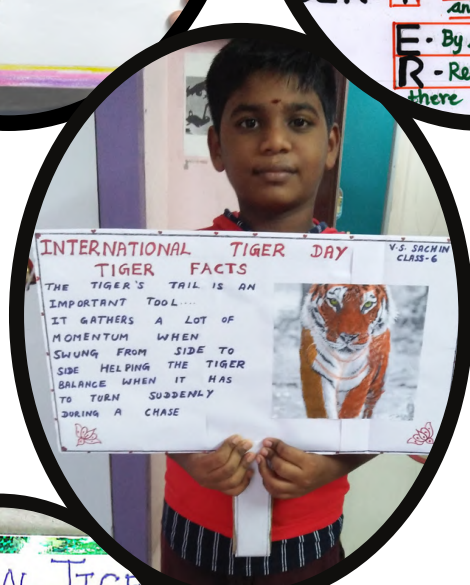

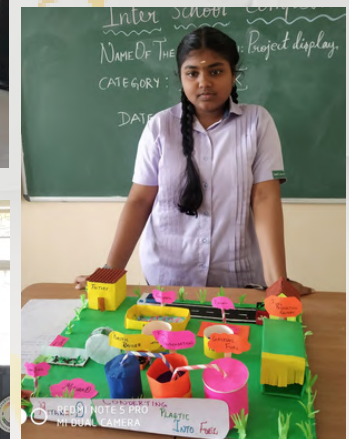
Libraries allow children to ask questions about the world and find the answers. The wonderful thing is that once a child learns to use a library, the doors to learning are always open.
