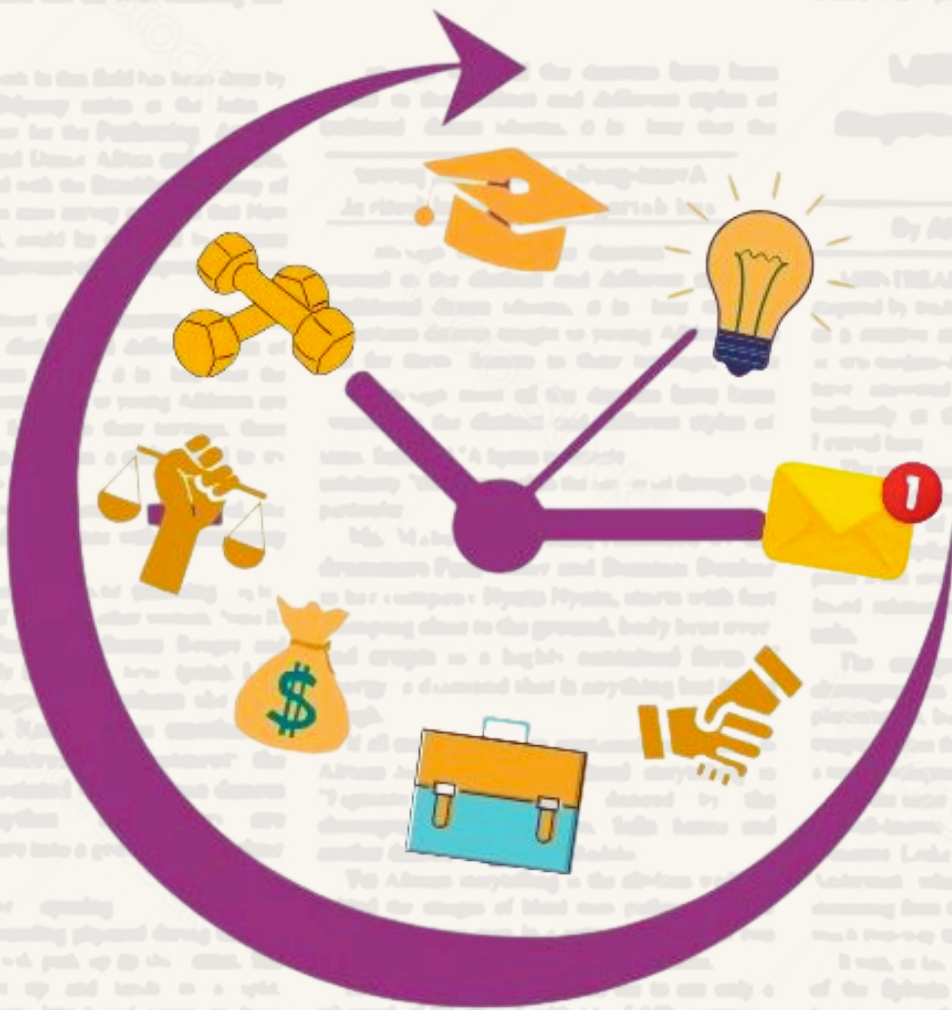

Students presented cultural performances showcasing the rich diversity of India, also paying tribute to the brave men and women of our armed forces.



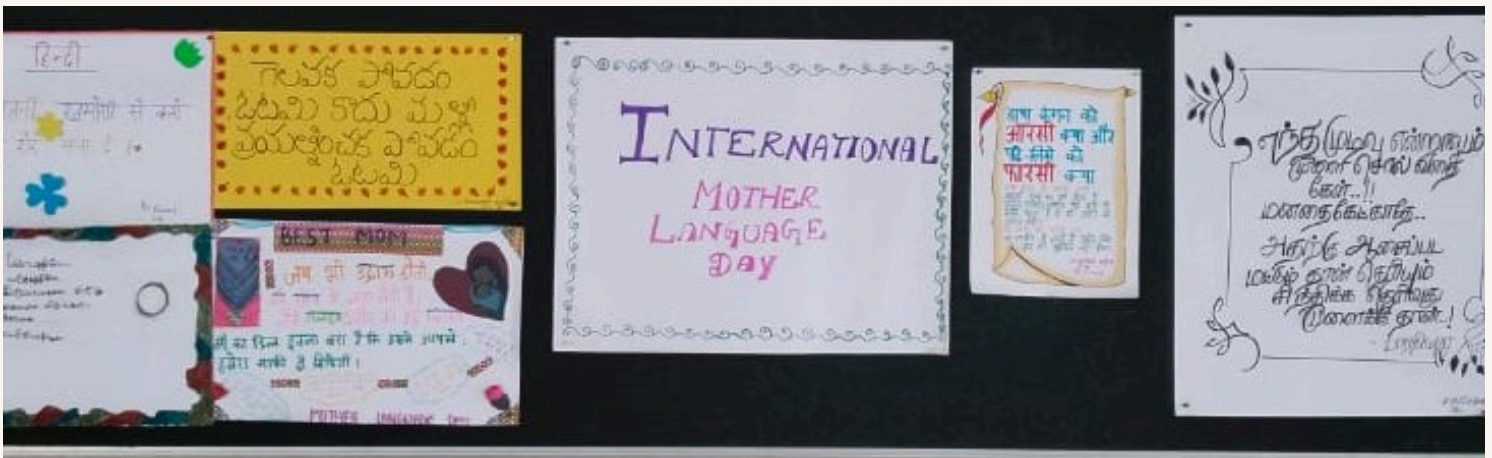
FAREWELL

Teachers' training workshop covered a diverse range of crucial topics aimed at enhancing professional development and pedagogical effectiveness.



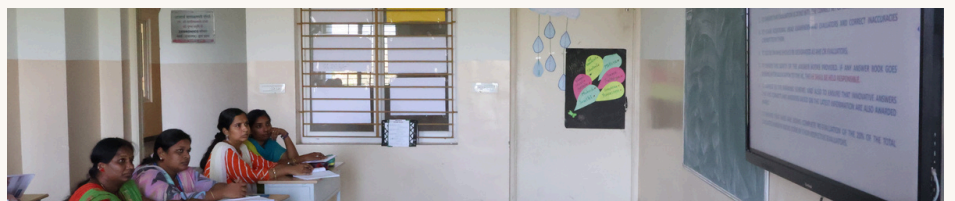
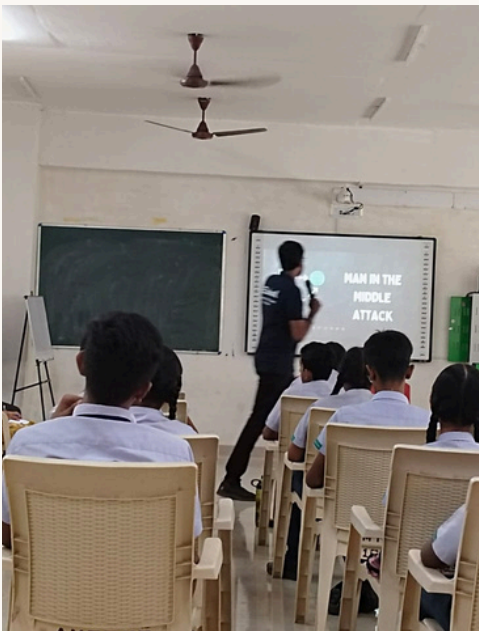
Teachers developed practical skills in budgeting, saving and investing, which they could apply in their personal life. It also empowered educators to play a vital role in shaping students' financial future.
